


Sun Fire[™] 6800 System Installation Instructions for Sun StorEdge[™] UniPack Boot Subsystem

Rails and a tray are required to install the UniPack Boot subsystem above the Sun Fire 6800 system.


Installing the Rails

→ Install the rails as shown in the figure below. Mount the rails at holes 98 and 101 in the system cabinet support beams.




Installing the Tray

→ Slide the tray into position until the screw holes align with the rails. Attach with the provided screws. Do not tighten at this time.




Installing the UniPack Drives

- Inspect the UniPack drives.
 Confirm that four rubber feet are present and intact on the underside of the drive.
- Orient the drive so the connector end is away from the center of the tray and slide it into the tray as far as the center stiffener.Do not to disturb the rubber feet on the drive.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 for each drive.



- 4. Tighten all tray mounting screws.
- 5. Align the tabs of the hold-down brackets and install as shown below.



- 6. Connect the power for the UniPack drives. See the wiring diagram on the following paenl.
 - a. From the front RTU, use power cords from J5 and J9.
 - b. From the rear RTU, use power cords from J3 and J9.

Note — Power cables J5 and J9 from the front RTU must be rerouted back to the front of the cabinet and up the front to the UniPack tray.
